Newly enacted Wisconsin Working Lands Initiative tax credit program: Department must inventory all 400 participants in Outag. Co. to certify farms are in compliance with state soil and water conservation standards (ATCP 50). Department will also be responsible to assist those who are not compliant by prescribing conservation practices to bring them into compliance. Will vote on a \$50 fee for compliance certification. WLI also requires counties to inspect participating farms at least once every 4 years for compliance.</p>
